Summitview School is excited to have Libby Weir, a professional artist from Jasper, AB, join us as an artist in residence.

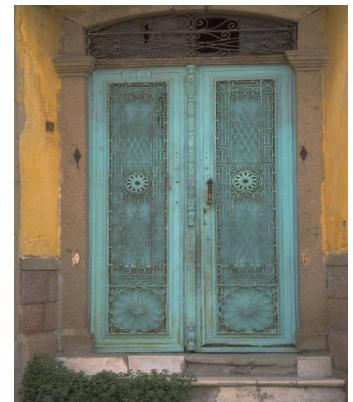
The Artist in Residence program allows us to bring Miss Weir into our school for three full weeks to work with all of our students to learn art techniques.
